Ca.12:30: Free time.

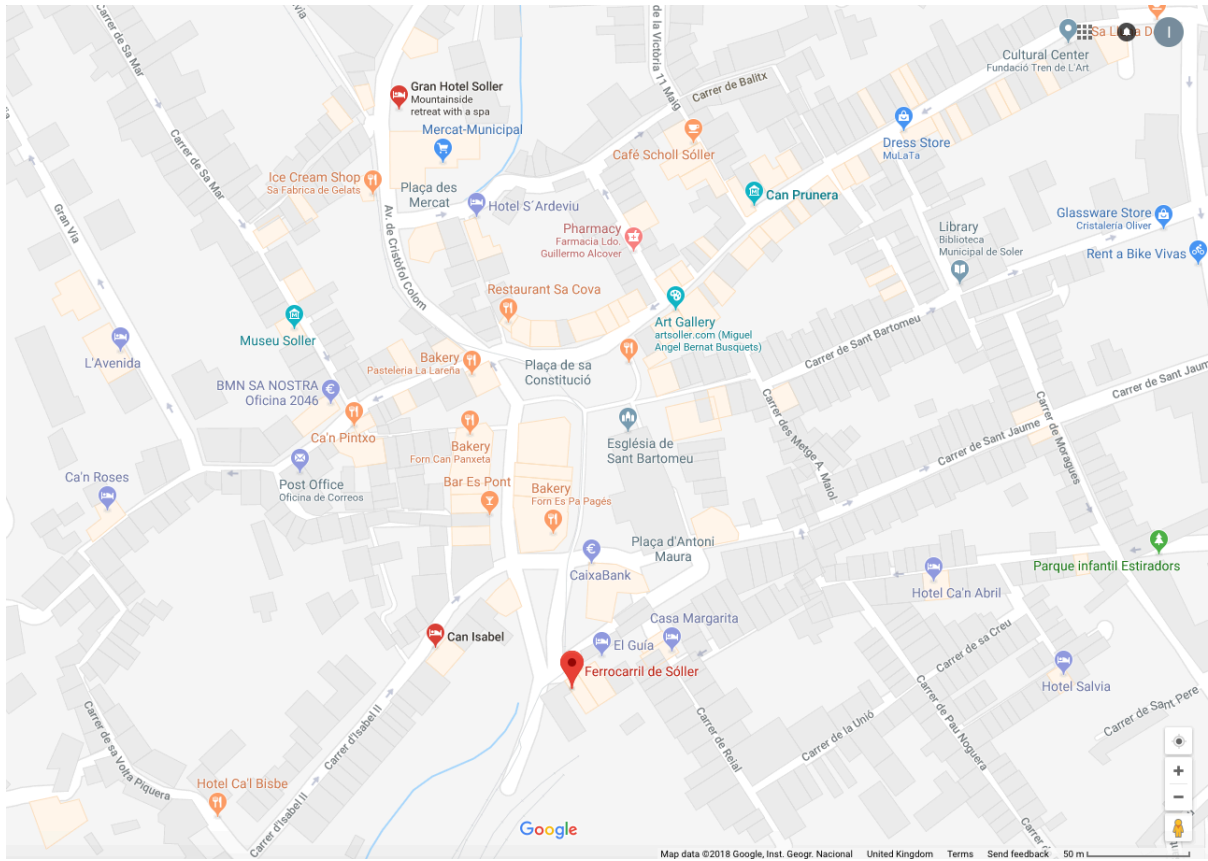
Feel free to explore Sóller at will. You can for lunch in Sóller, or to take the historical tram to go to the port and eat there, or just mill around and go for a nice walk.
